

PVA AppendPDF Module

For Open Text Content Server 10.x and Livelink 9.7.x

Create a Single PDF Document from Multiple PDF Files

The Append PDF module allows users to combine multiple PDF files to a single PDF document. The user can also change the default order of the PDF files when an appended PDF file is created or updated.

The module can use either the OPENTEXT eSign module or Appligent's AppendPDF™ software. It's easy to install, configure, and use.

The module maintains the relationship of the master and the components, and can be regenerated if any of the components have been changed. It speeds up the publishing process, and allows the generation of a single table of contents and bookmarks for the merged documents.
